Divine Mercy Minute:

Corporal Works of Mercy: Visit the Sick

"I went in and rendered a service to a seriously sick person. When I returned to my room, I suddenly saw the Lord Jesus, who said, My daughter, you gave Me greater pleasure by rendering Me that service than if you had prayed for a long time. I answered, "But it was not to You, Jesus, but to that patient that I rendered this service." And the Lord answered me, "Yes, my daughter, but whatever you do for your neighbor, you do for Me." (1029)

Teach your children to tend the sick at home. Whenever someone is sick at home, take that time to teach empathy to your children. The sick family member gets to choose what is on TV and what to eat. Everyone helps with the sick person's chores. By doing this we remind our children that loving someone means being willing to make sacrifices. Helping a sick sibling or parent helps children to grow in mercy, so they get in the habit of sharing mercy with others.

Jesus, I Trust in You

Tend to the sick outside your home. There are many ways to visit the sick; 1) Give blood 2) Spend time volunteering at a nursing home – Get creative and make use of your talents (e.g. sing, read, paint, call Bingo, etc.)! 3) Take time on a Saturday to stop and visit with an elderly neighbor. 4) Offer to assist caregivers of chronically sick family members on a one-time or periodic basis. 5) Give caregivers time off from their caregiving responsibilities so they can rest, complete personal chores, or enjoy a relaxing break. 6) Next time you make a meal that can be easily frozen, make a double batch and give it to a family in your parish who has a sick loved one.

Send a card and gift of prayer. If you can't visit, schedule a Mass at your parish, then send a Mass card for healing to the person that is ill and promise your prayers. There is a free app called Echo Prayer Manager (new.echoprayer.com) that will remind you to pray for the sick while they are recovering. Send a card to someone who is in the hospital, this small gesture can brighten their day.
